### **Apply for Student Teaching**

Apply 1-year in advance through the Office of Clinical Experiences ([www.ehhs.kent.edu/oce](http://www.ehhs.kent.edu/oce)). See student teaching link for application on the web through: [oss.educ.kent.edu](http://oss.educ.kent.edu). Student Teaching application deadline is the second Friday of each term.

### **Praxis II**

Take the following Praxis II test required for licensure: Speech Language Pathology (code 20330) with a minimum passing score of a 600 or Audiology (code 10340) with a minimum passing score of 600. Please note: Scores must be sent to Kent State University (recipient codes 0233 and 1367). ### **Licensure Application**

Pick up in 304 WH or download from [www.ode.state.oh.us](http://www.ode.state.oh.us) the 5-year licensure packet prior to student teaching. Submit the application to 304 WH once you've passed Praxis II (attach a copy of the first page of the score report). Electronic fingerprinting can be done in 221 White Hall Monday-Thursday from 8:30 a.m.-8:00 p.m. and on Friday from 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

### **Moral Character**

The Ohio Department of Education requires each person who will be working in schools with children to attest to good moral character. If you answer "Yes" to any of the questions listed below or have any questions/concerns, please contact a Program Counselor at the phone number listed above.

1. Have you ever been convicted of, found guilty of or pled guilty to any misdemeanor other than traffic offenses?

3. Have you ever had a criminal conviction sealed or expunged?
4. Have you ever had a teaching certificate limited, suspended or revoked?
5. Have you ever surrendered a teaching certificate, license or permit?
